Blackboard Learn

To ensure stability of Blackboard system, BOR college presidents voted to move Blackboard system from in-house hosting to Blackboard, Inc. managed hosting. According to Joe McAuliffe, Interium CIO, "There will be no updates to a higher version of the software at the time of the transition, and faculty will not need to make any adjustments or changes to their courses, or learn any new functionality". However, there might be up to 72 hours Blackboard downtime during winter break. The exact dates of server downtime will be announced as it becomes available.

Two sessions of Getting Started with Blackboard will be held before the Spring semester: Tuesday, January 14th, 9:30am - 12:00pm and Wednesday, January 15th, 1:00pm-3:30pm. Seat reservation requests may be sent to mxccdistance@mxcc.edu.
