General Education Requirements and Program Prerequisites for Middlesex Students

FOREIGN LANGUAGE COMPETENCY

Required: The second intermediate level of a second language must be met by any of the following:

- 1. 3 years high school level of the same language or
- 2. 2 years high school level plus the 2nd year (Intermediate I and II) college level or
- 3. Two years of college level language, Elementary I and II and Intermediate I and II or
- 4. Successful completion of language equivalency exam at UConn

Note: (1) Online or hybrid courses may <u>not</u> be used for Foreign Language at UConn

(2) If possible, language requirements should be met <u>before</u> transferring to UConn

WRITING COMPETENCY - 2 classes for 6 CREDITS

Required: ENGL 1010 or ENGL 1011

Required:

- b. STAT 1000Q or other transferable statistics courses listed on the UConn transfer site

Note: MATH 1071Q is not offered at MxCC. If using 1070Q & 1071Q, you will have to take a math course at a UConn branch or other community college before transferring to UConn.

Note: PSY* 111 taken at Middlesex, Gateway, or Tunxis Community Colleges will <u>NOT</u> satisfy this requirement. You can wait to take PSYC 1100 at UConn or take PSY* 111 at another Community College.

Required: One science course with a laboratory, must be at least 4 credits.

Note: Online or Hybrid laboratory science courses do <u>not</u> transfer to UConn.

ELECTIVE & GENERAL EDUCATION COURSES

The UConn degree in Business requires a minimum of 120 degree credits. Included in this total are 44-50 credits in your major and 60 credits of non-business courses. General education courses on this sheet can be included in this 60 credit total. A maximum of 9 credits in Economics and 6 in Statistics are allowed in the non-business courses.

Depending on the major chosen, there are an additional 10 to 16 open elective credits that must be completed. Most MxCC courses with the prefix BBG, BMG, BFN, BES, BMK, CST and CSC transfer to UConn as BA 1000 level electives, counting towards these open elective credits.

GRADES AND GPA REQUIREMENTS

GAP students must achieve a final cumulative grade point average (GPA) of **3.3 or higher** before transferring to UConn.

Non-GAP students must earn a minimum of 2.0 cumulative grade point average in all School of Business courses numbered 3000/4000-level plus ACCT 2001 and ACCT 2101 in order to apply to the Business program. *Please note:* Although 2.0 is the minimum GPA for these courses for non-GAP students to *apply* to the Business program, most students *admitted* to the program have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or higher.

BUSINESS CRITICAL REQUIRED COURSES – 8 COURSES

GAP students must complete the following courses with a grade of **B or higher** <u>prior</u> to transferring to UConn's School of Business.
