



Information on SNAP Education and Training Program

See if you qualify:

1. On SNAP benefit for the whole course. Cannot get TANF (cash assistance) from DSS.
2. Offer classes in a variety of career areas: CNA, PCT (if already a registered and licensed CNA), Pharmacy Tech, Phlebotomy, Certified Security Guard, Human Services Asst. and Veterinary Asst. Look at the descriptions and lengths of these classes on the MxCC website. <http://mxcc.edu/ce/courses/>. The schedules vary. Some courses meet in more than one place and some are longer than others.
3. ***To enroll, you will need a picture ID as a US citizen, SNAP card, Social Security card.*** Must be able to meet the physical and time requirements of the course – no problems with transportation or childcare.
4. CNA, Phlebotomy, and other courses require physical exam forms, immunization proof, and PPD tests. Enrollment in all classes requires passing the English and Math Accuplacer tests (<http://mxcc.edu/bsa/>.) You schedule this after your application is submitted to us.
5. No past criminal record – clinical employers will do background checks and drug screens. The federal/state grant states “students must be fully employable after training”. We check the CT Judicial Database for any record.
6. **Maintain an active email account so MxCC can communicate with you. It is how the program will communicate with you.**
7. There will be two information sessions on 11/29/17 and 12/4/17 for Spring 2018 classes. You will hear about the program, ask questions, and get an application.
