The English Studies Associate Degree at MxCC is part of the Connecticut State College and University Transfer Articulation Program (TAP). Students who complete an Associate Degree in English Studies at Middlesex can seamlessly transfer to Eastern, Central, Southern, Western, or Charter Oak, with junior status and only 60-63 credits remaining to complete a bachelor's degree in English.

How It Works

Step 1:

Students meet with an English Department faculty advisor to enroll in MxCC's TAP in English Studies.

Step 2:

Students follow course of study requirements, completing the first 60-61 credits at Middlesex, earning their associate degree.

Step 3:

Students transfer to Eastern, Western, Central, Southern, or Charter Oak, completing the final 60-63 credits, earning a bachelor's degree in English or English/Literature.

English Program Requirements Overview

- Students will follow a semester -by-semester recommended course of study
- Students will complete 36-37 credits of General Education Requirements
- Students will fulfill 9 credits of English major program requirements in American Literature, British Literature, and Mythology
- Students will fulfill 15 credits of unrestricted English major program elective requirements based on the student's desired transfer institution
- Students must earn an overall 2.0 grade point average in order to graduate and be guaranteed admission to one of the four State Universities or Charter Oak State College
