

Memorandum of Understanding

Middlesex Community College – Nutrition and Dietetics Advising Pathway
to
Gateway Community College – Nutrition and Dietetics Associate’s Degree

Students from Middlesex Community College (Middlesex) who successfully complete the Nutrition and Dietetics Advising Pathway will transfer 29 credits to Gateway Community College (Gateway) which can be applied to courses required by the Nutrition and Dietetics Associate’s Degree Program, as indicated below.

Course Equivalencies

- HLT 103 and NTR 100, an online 1-credit course developed for this pathway, will collectively meet program requirements for NTR 101.
- MAT 137 will meet program requirements for MAT 115
- COM 173 will meet program requirements for COM 171

Students need not take NTR 100 concurrently with HLT 103 in order to have the courses transfer into Gateway’s program as NTR 101. Students may transfer into the program at any time, and need not complete the pathway at MxCC. All courses (except NTR 100) can be applied to requirements of the General Studies Associate in Science Degree, and the Liberal Arts and Sciences Associate in Arts Degree at MxCC. MxCC teaching qualifications for BIO 111 include an RD license.

Students must be in good academic standing with an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher and must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 in courses required for the major.


