Proposal Description/Rationale	During the past three years I have worked with many students who have diagnosed disabilities in the area of math that prevent them from completing MxCC's math requirements. In many instances this one requirement prevents them from completing a degree program at MxCC. Some of those students may be capable of completing a different math course. Others may be capable of completing an alternate course such as logic, business math, statistics or nutrition that could fulfill their graduation requirement. I have also discovered that as an institution we do not have a formal mechanism for students to submit their documentation and request a substitution or a waiver. Each individual student I've worked with has spoken with math faculty, division chairs and sometimes deans. In terms of our efforts to increase retention and graduation I am asking for the creating of a committee where such requests can be formerly presented.Even if waivers or substitutions are ultimately not granted a formal committee allows students to be heard in a way they feel unheard currently.
	In the field of disability services many institutions have processes in place to address the need of disabled students in meeting general academic requirements. For example foreign language waivers and substitutions are common for students with disabilities. Recognizing that for the lack of one course a student could be a college graduate I'm asking MxCC to consider and develop a process, procedure and alternative to MAT 104 or higher to allow students with diagnosed math disabilities the means of obtaining their college degree.


