

## Middletown Adult Education College & Career Center & Middlesex Community College Transitional Strategies Package Spring 2019

- Eligible students
  - Students who place in ENG096 or MAT095I or 095 courses.
  - Students who need to retake one or more developmental Math and/or English courses.
  - Students who are eligible for Fast Track Workshops (refer to Accuplacer Results Sheet).
  - Students who need intermediate-to-advanced ESL/ELL.
- Students take **COL110** College Success (evening section) **and** a Math and/or an English Fast Track Workshop. The ESL workshop may also be taken with any of these combinations.
- No course charge for package. Cost Savings!
- If you are on Financial Aid, please check with the Financial Aid office to ensure that you are meeting your requirements if you are taking other MxCC courses.
- Upon workshop completion, students will retake the Accuplacer to see if they can move up to College Level or College Level with Embedded Support. An Accuplacer pretest is required to be on file. Students, though, can take this package concurrent with other MxCC courses.
- Students can use services, career and financial, at both MxCC and Middletown Adult Ed.

### Course Descriptions

#### **English Fast Track Workshop (0 credits), EDUC 1003** **CRN: 1002**

Feb. 25, 2019 – May 16, 2019 (includes Accuplacer post test)

**Mon./Weds., 5:30-7 pm, Middletown Adult Education, room 119**

This non-credit, fast-track workshop is designed to help students refresh their skills in essay writing, grammar, and reading comprehension. The workshop will be particularly beneficial for students placing at the intensive level but are open to all students. At the end of the workshop, students may retake a placement test to see if they can progress to College Level or College Level with Embedded Support.

#### **Math Fast Track Workshop (0 credits), EDUC 1002** **CRN: 1001**

Feb. 25, 2019 – May 16, 2019 (includes Accuplacer post test)

**Mon./Weds., 7:30-9 pm, Middletown Adult Education, room 119**

This noncredit workshop is designed to help students refresh their skills in arithmetic and elementary algebra concepts. The workshop is targeted to benefit students placing at the intensive levels. At the end of the workshop, students may retake the placement test to see if they can progress to a course that is College Level or College Level with Embedded Support.

#### **College Success (1 credit), COL110** **CRN: 1405**

Feb. 19, 2018 – end of the semester

**Tues., 5:10-6:25 pm, Middlesex Community College, Snow Hall, room 504**

This course is designed to introduce new students to the college and its resources; to help them adopt skills necessary for college success; and to help new students feel connected to the college, its faculty and staff, and their fellow students. Special emphasis will be placed on career exploration for the purpose of helping students develop academic and career goals and encouraging them to enroll in career and technical education programs.

**ESL Transition to English (0 credits), Spin1140****CRN: 1003****Tues./Thurs., 12:30-2pm, Middletown Adult Education, room 119**

This is an intermediate-to-advanced ESL course designed to assist students in their transition to English courses in college. Focus will be upon pronunciation, vocabulary, grammar, reading, basic writing, and speaking. Some individualized, self-paced instruction will be included. Students will be post tested to determine English course level.
