**Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:** This position reports to the Associate Professor/Program Coordinator for the Ophthalmic Dispensing and Design program. The Assistant Professor will teach 15 credit/contact hours per semester in Ophthalmic Dispensing and Design with special emphasis on courses that require the supervision and services of a licensed Optician. The successful candidate must have demonstrated an interest in and an aptitude for teaching the full range of our courses. S/he must be committed to adopting innovative instructional approaches along with current instructional techniques; integrating instructional technology; developing and delivering distance learning courses; and, collaborating with colleagues to maintain departmental standards and initiatives. Other responsibilities include related curriculum/course development; academic advisement for students; service on college committees; continued professional development by maintaining membership in professional organizations and developing liaisons with colleagues in the field as well as those teaching in high school and four-year institutions of higher education; and other service responsibilities related to a full-time faculty position in support of the mission of the college and the goals of the division.

**General Experience:**

Master's degree in Health, Education, Business or other related field, current State of CT Optician License, current ABO-NCLE Certification and a minimum of 4 years of college teaching experience, **OR** Bachelor of Science degree in Health, Education, Business or other related field with minimum 5 years of optical experience, current State of CT Optician License, current ABO-NCLE Certification and a minimum of 2 years of college teaching experience.

**Special Experience:** Preferred experience includes Master's degree in Health, Education, Business or other related field, optical related teaching experience; computer literacy, including experience with instructional applications; working with community college students of varying abilities; an understanding of the mission of the community college; demonstrated involvement in support of diversity; a commitment to civic engagement and community service activities; and, ability to respond to and work with multiple constituencies.
