Achieving the Dream: Key Performance Indicators (KPI)

KPI's are tracked across all 12 community colleges to measure institutional performance related to student access, progress, completion, cost, and post-college outcomes. Nationally, students who earn 24+ credits and complete Math & English in the first year of college are four times more likely to graduate than students who do not meet these metrics.

Early Momentum Metrics

Credit accumulation in the first year

Gateway Math and English completion in first year

Persistence 1st term to 2nd term; 1st year to 2nd year
