How Pass/Fail Works

Pass/Fail is a Spring 2020 policy allowing students to elect special grade notations in place of traditional grades. The purpose of Pass/Fail is to exclude grades you do not wish reflected in your GPA.

It is strongly suggested you consult with your Academic Advisor or Graduation Auditor prior to invoking the Pass/Fail option.

What does CRT, CR, NCE or W mean?

Grade Notation

Description

CRT

Stands for Credit for Transfer.
Students earn credit for the class being awarded.

Count towards approved majors, as well as, for general education courses and electives. Please consult with your Program Coordinator prior to electing this option. Not all major requirements may be satisfied with this option.

Will satisfy prerequisite requirements, though in some cases a grade above C will gain the student additional advantages, for instance qualify the student to skip a subsequent level.

CR

Stands for Credit. Students earn credit for the class being awarded.

Count towards general education courses

May not meet program or prerequisite requirements.

Grade Notation

Description

NCE

No Credit Earned.

Will not meet program or prerequisite requirements

W

Withdrawal; No Credit Earned

Will not meet program or prerequisite requirements.

Will the Pass/Fail grade notations transfer?

CRT

Will transfer and apply to major and general education requirements at any CSCU institution with or without the completion of an associate degree.

CRT may not transfer outside of the CSCU. Contact your transfer institution prior to invoking the Pass/Fail option.

CR

Will transfer to a CSCU institution with a completed associate degree.

NCE & W

Will not fulfill any requirements and is not transferrable.

Important Dates When Considering Pass/Fail

Thursday, May 21, 2020

Final Grades Post on mycommnet.

Tuesday, June 30, 2020

Last Day to Invoke Pass/Fail

Tuesday, June 1, 2021

Last Day to Request your Pass/Fail grade notation be reverted back to the original grade.

I am graduating this Spring 2020, can I invoke Pass/Fail?

Yes, you can but we recommend that you speak to your graduation auditor prior to invoking the Pass/Fail option to ensure this will not affect your award eligibility.

Important: Once your degree or certificate is awarded you not revert the Pass/Fail grade notation to the original grade.

When will the Pass/Fail be reflected on my transcript?

Final grades for the Spring 2020 semester will be posted on Thursday, May 21, 2020. The Registrar's Office will begin processing Pass/Fail requests starting Friday, May 22, 2020 until the deadline on Tuesday, June 30, 2020. Final GPAs will be recalculated after the deadline of June 30, 2020.

Can I revert my Pass/Fail grade notation back to my original grade?

If you have not been awarded a degree or certificate from GCC, you will be allowed to revert the grade back one-time. This option must be invoked prior to June 1, 2021.
