

Blackboard Learn: How to Import a Backup File (Restore a course)

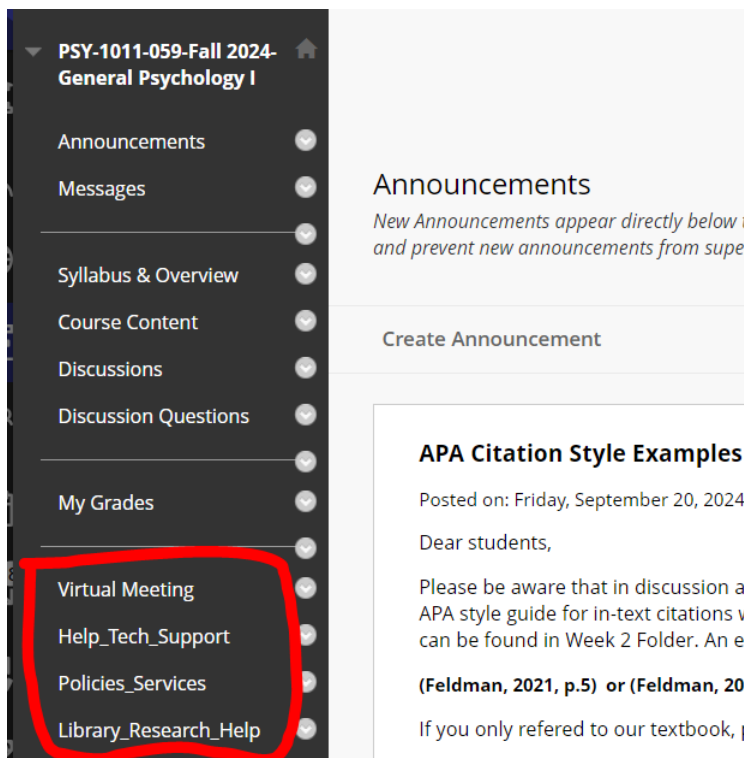
To reuse the same content from a course, you may use “Import” feature to import a “backup .zip” file without student data to an existing course. If you would like to restore a backup .zip file with students’ data for a grade challenge, you will first contact Distance Learning to create a blank shell in Blackboard. Then you will use the same step to import the backup .zip file with student data. There are two steps in importing a backup file to a course.

Step 1. Examine the course that you would like to import content from a .zip backup file.

Step 2. Import the backup .zip file.

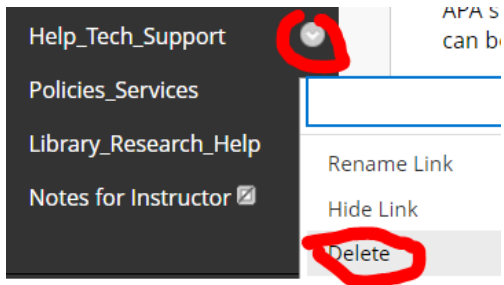
Step 1. Examine the course that you would like to import content from a .zip backup file.

- (1) Enter the course. On the Blackboard **Courses** page, click on the course name such as [PSY-F1011-Fall2024-General Psychology I](#).
- (2) You will see the MxCC template in the course. There are a group of links on the Course Menu. If you use the same links in your previous course, you should delete the links here.



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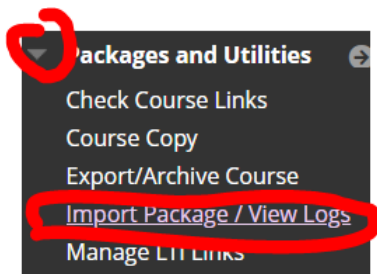
(3) Click on the action icon next to a link such as Help_Tech_Support and click on “Delete”.



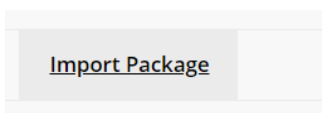
(4) Use the same steps as (3) to delete all duplicate links in the Course Menu.

Step 2. Import the backup .zip file.

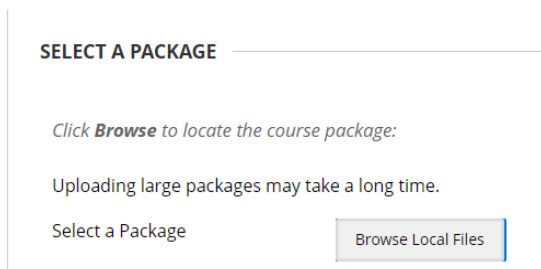
(1) To import a content backup file, under “Control Panel”, click “Packages and Utilities” and then click “Import Packages/View Logs”.



(2) Click on “Import Packages” button.

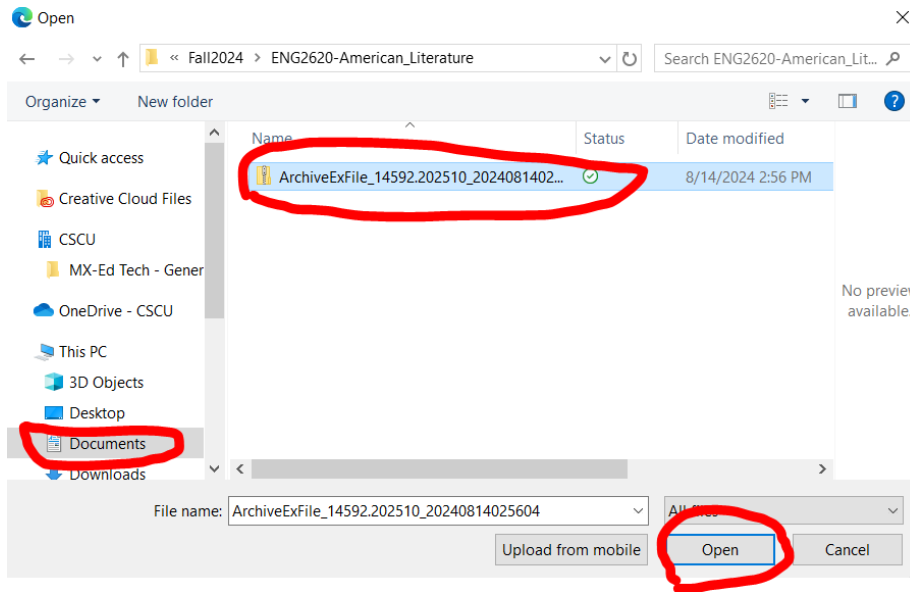


(3) Under SELECT A PACKAGE, click on “Browse Local Files” button.



(4) Locate the backup .zip file on your computer and click on “Open”.

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(5) Select the links and tools you would like to import: Content Areas, Discussion Board-Include only the forums, with no starter posts, Grade Center Columns and Settings, Rubrics, Settings, Tests, Surveys and Pools.

- Content Areas
- Content Alignments
- Discussion Board
 - Include starter posts for each thread in each forum (anonymized)
 - Include only the forums, with no starter posts
- Glossary
- Grade Center Columns and Settings
- Group Settings
- Journals
- Retention Center Rules
- Rubrics
- Settings
 - Banner Image
 - Course Guest Access
 - Course Observer Access
 - Language Pack
 - Navigation Settings
- Tests, Surveys, and Pools

(6) Click "Submit".

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- (7) Depending on the size of your course, you may need to wait for a few minutes until the .zip file has been completed imported to the course.
- (8) You may need to log out Blackboard and log back on to see the imported content.
